


BLOOD SERVICES ACTIVITY REPORT

The Blood Resources Program, a subdivision of the Clinical Laboratory Evaluation Program of the Wadsworth Center, collects data annually on the collection and distribution of blood and blood components by entities that hold a blood bank permit in Blood Services – Collection, Blood Services – Collection Autogeneic Only, Blood Services – Transfusion Service and Blood Services – Transfusion Storage Only.

Note that in 2022, legislation was passed creating a separate registration process for Source Plasma Donation Centers, therefore data on source plasma collected for manufacture is not represented in this report.


Total Units of Red Blood Cells in Circulation: 1,498,691

Total Units of of Single Donor Platelets in Circulation: 412,248





Total Units of of Plasma in Circulation: 700,322




AUTOGENEIC COLLECTION Whole Blood

Total Units in Circulation: 103




AUTOGENEIC COLLECTIONRed Blood Cells

Total Units in Circulation: 1,335




DIRECTED DONOR COLLECTIONRed Blood Cells

DIRECTED DONOR COLLECTIONSingle Donor Platelets


